- Be in good standing with LSLIB
- Strong reading/comprehension skills and good communication skills

Application Process:

Applicants are required to submit a letter (outlining why they want to be appointed to the Housing Committee and how their background, knowledge and experience will lend to the success of the Housing Committee) as well as a copy of their resume.

As diversity is a consideration for appointments, Applicants are encouraged to provide information on current living situation, housing affordability, youth, adult or elder perspective.

Selection Process:

Applications will be received by the Housing Department and forwarded to the Housing Committee for review and recommendation to Chief and Council. When appointed, applicants will be advised in writing and be required to agree to the Code of Conduct and sign an Oath of Confidentiality as reports include small scale statistics and tenant-oriented information.

Compensation and Commitment:

Housing Committee meetings are held quarterly. Committee members must be willing to commit to attend meetings as set and agreed. Honoraria is in accordance with LSLB policy and the Housing Committee Terms of Reference.
